FOOD PANTRY UPDATES AND IMPORTANT DATES: The Food Pantry of Galena, Hudson, Kankakee & Wills Township thanks you for your continued support of our local food pantry located at the United Methodist Church in Rolling Prairie. In addition to providing food for sustenance, we offer job postings, nutrition facts, library access, and a kind word of support. We have approximately 125 clients and as of June 21, 2018 those clients visited the pantry 488 times. Each client family can visit twice per month. The cost of food provided is \$30.00 for a small family and \$34.00 for a large family. Fundraising is important! What spiritual benefits are received by being a Rosary Sodality Member?

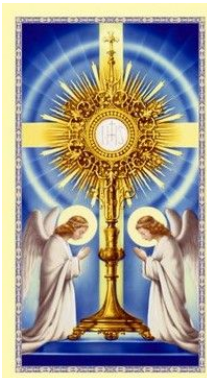
- A Mass is said on the first Sunday of the month for the living and deceased Rosary members

What are the membership details?

- Meetings are held March through December on the second Wednesday of the month in the Church hall at 7:00 PM Central Time.
- Members are asked to pay a \$5.00 yearly membership fee and to help host and provide refreshments for one meeting per year.
- Members can participate in an August outing each year, when we go to a fun or interesting place. All members, their spouses and friends are welcome to join us.
