FOOD PANTRY UPDATES AND IMPORTANT DATES: The Food Pantry of Galena, Hudson, Kankakee & Wills Township thanks you for your continued support of our local food pantry located at the United Methodist Church in Rolling Prairie. In addition to providing food for sustenance, we offer job postings, nutrition facts, library access, and a kind word of support. We have approximately 125 clients and as of June 21, 2018 those clients visited the pantry 488 times. Each client family can visit twice per month. The cost of food provided is \$30.00 for a small family and \$34.00 for a large family.
