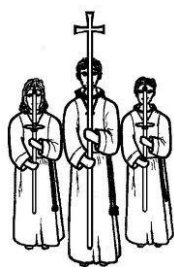

CATHOLIC SERVICE APPEAL: Our annual diocesan fund drive (CSA) has begun. The Diocese has completely **CHANGED THE PROCEDURE FOR COLLECTING AND HANDLING THE FUNDS.** An offering envelope will be mailed directly to you from the Diocese that you may bring to the parish **OR** that you may send directly to the Diocese. Any checks are to be made out to **THE DIOCESE OF GARY** and **NOT** to the parish. If you bring the envelope to the parish, we will send it **UNOPENED** directly to an agency the Diocese has hired to coordinate the fund drive. This will greatly simplify the collection process and free parish personnel from the complicated task of managing the drive. If you do not receive an envelope from the Diocese in the mail this first year, they will be available to

you at Mass on the weekend of April 27th and 28th. As in the past, any donations that **exceed** our **assigned goal**, this year of \$8,846.00, will be returned to the parish. In addition, the Bishop has decided to **also** return 10% of the assigned goal amount to the parish as well, if the goal is reached.
