**CATHOLIC SERVICE APPEAL:** Our annual diocesan fund drive (CSA) has begun. The Diocese has completely CHANGED THE PROCEDURE FOR COLLECTING AND HANDLING THE FUNDS.

An offering envelope will be mailed directly to you from the Diocese that you may bring to the parish OR that you may send directly to the Diocese. Any checks are to be made out to THE DIOCESE OF GARY and NOT to the parish. If you bring the envelope to the parish, we will send it UNOPENED directly to an agency the Diocese has hired to coordinate the fund drive. This will greatly simplify the collection process and free parish personnel from the complicated task of managing the drive. If you do not receive an envelope from the Diocese in the mail this first year, they will be available to you at Mass. As in the past, any donations that exceed our assigned goal, this year of \$8,846.00, will be returned to the parish. In addition, the Bishop has decided to return 10% of the assigned goal amount to the parish as well, if the goal is reached.



**TOTUS TUUS IS BACK!!:** Set aside the week of July 14th at St. John Kanty in Rolling Prairie, for another fun-filled, faith-packed stretch of activity this summer with Totus Tuus. A crew of college students will be back again to set fire under our children this year for a week of jammed filled: excitement.
